### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

#### **SUMMARY:**

The Town of Yucca Valley and the San Bernardino County Sheriff's Department, Morongo Basin Station, request input for an Off Highway Vehicle Enforcement Grant. The grant seeks to obtain funds from the California Department of Parks & Recreation, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division, (OHMVR) to be used for the enforcement of laws related to the illegal use of Off-Highway Vehicles, rider education, and the purchase of support equipment. Grant funds are obtained from green sticker OHV registration fees. The Town's current OHV enforcement program is funded through an OHMVR Grant, but this grant is due to expire in early 2008. The meeting will be held to discuss the application process for another grant to continue funding for the 2008/2009 fiscal year.
